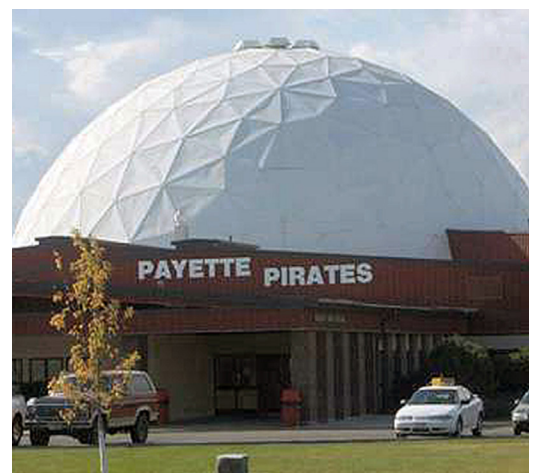


THE DISTRICT AT-A-GLANCE

The Payette School District students and their families are nestled among a population of 7,655. The school buildings sit on 130 acres of meticulously maintained grounds, including a landmark sport dome. Our district cautiously budgets state, federal, grant and levy tax dollars. In fiscal year 2022, the Payette High School cafeteria was doubled, and the District Office was moved to the Presidio High School location. The school's nutrition program provides breakfast, snack, lunch, and some after school meals. All students receive free breakfast and lunch. Many programs across the district are recognized for excellence, including the primary school chess club, elementary and middle school robotics programs, one of the largest Idaho Drug Free Youth clubs and a highly accomplished band program.

THE COMMUNITY

Payette, Idaho is uniquely situated close to world class skiing, white water rafting, hiking, fishing, hunting, and every conceivable type of outdoor recreation. The peaceful retreats of McCall and Sun Valley and the vibrant city of Boise, rated as one of the top places to live in America, are only a short drive away. This makes the historic pioneer town of Payette an ideal place to live.

Within our town lies a state-of-the-art public library, fire station, popular 18-hole golf course, beautiful parks, and a year-round indoor/outdoor public pool. Idaho's 1st Miracle Baseball Field, in honor of hometown hero Harmon Killebrew, benefits children with disabilities from near and far, bringing the community together. A Boys and Girls Club is a thriving youth development organization that offers numerous activities for children of all ages.

Local businesses generously support Payette School District and provide our residents with both necessary services and numerous amenities. US Highway 95, a major highway, runs through town with easy access to Eastern Oregon, Northern Idaho, and Nevada.

The median income is \$47,272 and real estate, whether existing homes on the market or new construction, is affordable. For the outdoor enthusiast, an abundance of activities are only minutes away (3 ski areas, 4 rivers, and many mountains). The neighboring community of Ontario, Oregon hosts a cultural center where fine arts opportunities such as painting and cooking classes are readily available. The Weiser Little Theatre provides acting and other theatric possibilities. Continuing education prospects are plentiful at nearby Treasure Valley Community College. Medical care is abundant with state-of-the-art healthcare facilities within 5 miles. Nearly every faith denomination holds services in the area.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES

The key responsibilities of the Superintendent include, but are not limited to, the following:



- Work with the Board of Trustees to provide leadership in all areas of teaching and learning, curriculum and instruction, assessment, professional development, and data analysis.
- Direct the work and provide supervision to instructional and classified staff.
- Implement the School District's Strategic Plan.
- Direct the preparation of the annual budget and recommend revenue sources. Supervise and direct purchases and expenditures within the limits of the budget.
- Establish and maintain effective communication and collaboration throughout the District and within the community.
- Assist the Board in negotiations with the local education organization.



THE QUALIFICATIONS

Payette School District seeks a dynamic, energetic individual to assume the leadership of the district. The following qualifications are required:



- Licensed, or eligible for licensure, as Superintendent in Idaho.
- Masters degree required.
- Superintendent, building principal, or central office experience.
- Human relations and team building capacity.
- Supervision and evaluation of staff toward meeting district goals.
- Experience in budgeting and finance.
- Technologically competent.
- Communication and public relation skills.

THE COMPENSATION

The Board is prepared to offer a competitive compensation package including a comprehensive benefits package and a salary range of \$110,000 to \$125,000 depending on experience.
