Harold B. Lee Elementary (400 students)

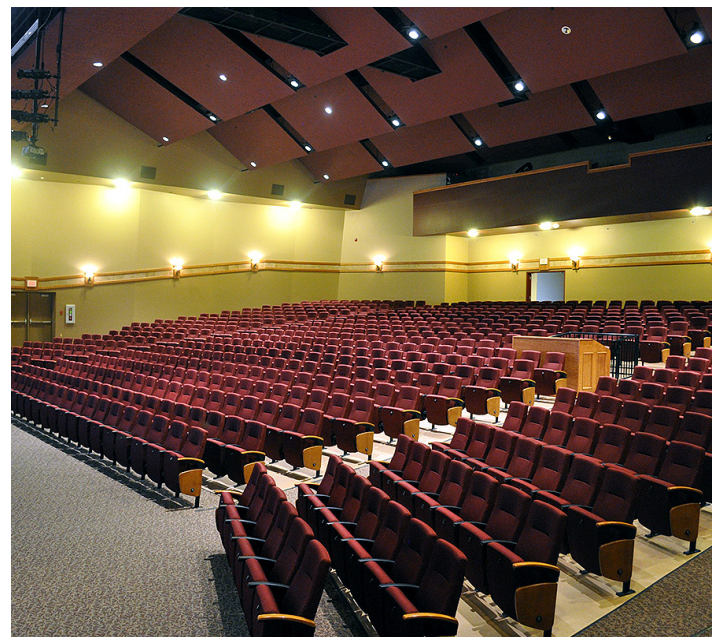
- One of the highest performing elementary schools in the state
